## Course Assessment

During your course, you will be required to sit a range of assessments. These will include both practical and written. Your trainers will provide you sufficient information prior to each assessment activity to ensure you understand your requirements. Learning and assessment support assistance will be given to participants who experience learning difficulties.

## Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) may be possible for part of or the entire course. Past training, formal and informal and/or experience can be assessed and matched against the units of competency within this course. Talk to us prior to enrolment if you feel you are eligible for RPL.

## Course Costs

The course costs include:

- Your student kit
- All materials used during the course
- All assessment activities
- Support throughout the course
- Re assessment if required (up to 2 attempts—you will be required to re-enrol into a unit if you fail to complete all assessments after the 2nd attempt)

If you are wanting to enrol in single units, full payment for that unit is due on enrolment plus a 'one off' administration fee.
