Unit Descriptions

HLTFA311A—Apply First Aid

This unit needs to be completed through another training organisation. It is the standard First Aid course that is offered by numerous training Organisations in every state. This course code has been upgraded to HLTAID003. It teaches participants the necessary skills to administer first aid care that may be required in emergency situations, as well as the tools needed to help treat serious injuries and other ailments.

HLTHIR301A—Communicate and work effectively in health

This unit builds skills and knowledge to work effectively in a health setting. It covers ethics, hygiene standards, maintaining professional work standards, promoting a positive approach to health and taking responsibility for personal skill development.

HLTWHS300A—Contribute to WHS processes

This unit specifies the workplace performance required by a practitioner to contribute to the work health and safety (WHS) processes and where their responsibilities are for themselves, clients and others.

HLTCOM405D—Administer a Practice

This unit builds the skills and knowledge to understand the legalities of business and apply this to planning and running a health care business including financial administration and marketing your business.

HLTCOM404C—Communicate effectively with clients

This unit covers the skills required by practitioners to establish and maintain effective communication with the client throughout all interactions and provide basic counselling as required and as appropriate to facilitate the client session.

HLTCOM406C—Make referrals to other health care professionals when appropriate

This unit teaches participants when they need to refer a client to another health care professional, arranging the referral along with interacting effectively with other health care professionals.

HLTCOM408D—Use specific health terminology to communicate effectively

This unit builds knowledge of common health terminology. This will assist you to communicate effectively with clients and other health care practitioners using appropriate health terminology. You will be able to apply this knowledge to understand health reports, scans and x-ray reports that clients may bring to their session and discuss these with them.

HLTIN301C—Comply with infection control policies and procedures

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required for practitioners to comply with infection control policies and procedures under Australian and New Zealand standards for maintaining infection control. It addresses the importance of applying these policies to ensure the safety of the client and personal protection to prevent transmission.

HLTAP401B—Confirm physical health status

This unit builds a detailed level of knowledge of anatomy and physiology required to confirm the physical health status of a client.

BSBWOR203B—Work effectively with others

This unit develops the skills and knowledge required to work in a group environment promoting team commitment and cooperation, supporting team members and dealing effectively with issues, problems and conflict.

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BTKCBS401A—Conduct a BodyTalk session

This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to conduct a BodyTalk session according to the philosophies and practices of the BodyTalk system.

This unit comprises the following key components:

1. BodyTalk Fundamentals (the old Modules 1 & 2) which can be undertaken with any IBA approved instructor
2. Orthopedic evaluation skills to assess a client before and after a BodyTalk session to demonstrate the physical changes in the body as result of the session*
3. Develop practice guidelines for your practice and meet ethical, legal and regulatory requirements*
4. IBA BodyTalk Certified Practitioner (CBP) exam. This means on completion of this unit you will be certified with the IBA

* Components 2 & 3 above are offered as part of the BodyTalk Fundamentals Integration course run by Melissa Smith. This then ensures that you recap the content of the Fundamentals course and meet the IBA requirements to undertake the CBP exam.

The assessment for this unit requires more than completing the CBP exam in order to meet Australian training standards. You will be required to film 25 of your BodyTalk sessions, complete some assignments including: the science of BodyTalk; BodyTalk compared with other natural therapies; developing your own clinic guidelines.

BTKCBS402A—Apply advanced principles of consciousness to BodyTalk sessions

This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to apply advanced principles of consciousness to BodyTalk sessions demonstrating the underpinning values and philosophies whilst using the BodyTalk Protocol and Exploring Procedure.

This unit comprises the following key components:

1. Complete the Advanced BodyTalk Protocol and Procedure (this is the DVD or online course available through the IBA)
2. Principles of Consciousness (the old Module 3) which can be undertaken with any IBA approved instructor

The assessment for this unit comprises filming of BodyTalk sessions, completing case studies, completing the IBA advanced exam for Principles of Consciousness and assignments.

What happens if you have completed any of these: BodyTalk Fundamentals, BodyTalk Orthopedic Evaluation, Principles of Consciousness, Advanced BodyTalk Protocol and Procedures

Any of these units you have already undertaken count towards the Certificate IV in BodyTalk and you do not have to repeat them and the costs for BTKCBS401A and or BTKCBS402A will be reduced. If you have completed all of these you will need to complete the additional assessment requirements and pay the fee associated with this.
